On December 3, 2019, an economic forum with the topic "The Bulgarian economy at the end of 2019. A small business perspective for 2020" was held at the Inter Continental Sofia Hotel. The focus of the event was on small and medium-sized businesses. The main purpose of the event was to create favorable conditions and prerequisites for business contacts between the representatives of the business circles in Bulgaria. The forum was attended by more than 150 participants and 30 representatives of diplomatic missions, including Project Countries.

The host of the event - Bulgaria Economic Forum (BEF), as a Project Partner of SmartRural Project, made a short presentation of the Project and the Stakeholder Network, which has to exchange business and innovative ideas related to rural areas and the rural economy in the framework of the upcoming project activities, including through the developed IT networking tool.
